#### **Devices everywhere**

Devices are getting smaller and more capable and can be used almost anywhere. This has obvious benefits but also some drawbacks. You won't always see what your child is doing on a device. Carefully consider this and the safeguards that you will put in place. Children's devices are likely to divert their attention away from other things that they are doing; they may sit down to do some homework, get a message on their device and an hour later, they still haven't started their work. Come up with ways you can support your child to maintain boundaries with their devices. E.g. keeping their phone in a safe place away from them whilst doing homework, or keeping their phone with you at bedtime.



#### Article 23 – Every child with a disability has a right to a full and decent life.

What does that mean? Every child with a disability, whether it be physical or neurological, should be given the support to thrive just like everyone else. They should be given support at school to ensure that they can achieve their goals, they should be able to join in with activities they enjoy and mostly, children with a disability, should feel included. Remember, a disability isn't who they are, it is part of what makes them, them!

Why not speak to your son/daughter about different types of disabilities and maybe read some storybooks which included characters with disabilities.
