**Science Skills**


- Use your observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions



<b>Battle/ battlefield</b>	A fight for control during a war. The battlefield is where the battle takes place.
<b>British Hotel</b>	A hut made of metal sheets, where soldiers could rest and buy hot food, drinks and equipment.
<b>Cholera</b>	A disease that affects the digestive system.
<b>Crimea</b>	A small part of Ukraine that is controlled by Russia.
<b>Troops</b>	A group of soldiers.
<b>Herbal</b>	A mixture made with natural herbs (plants).
<b>Jamaica</b>	A small island in the Caribbean Sea, off the coast of North America.
<b>War-torn country</b>	A country torn apart by war.
<b>Aztecs</b>	A group of fierce warriors who settled in the valley of Mexico in the 13 <sup>th</sup> century.
<b>Pioneer</b>	A person who is among the first to explore or develop a method for others to follow.
<b>Source</b>	Material that provides information.
<b>Timeline</b>	Various events ordered chronologically (events in the order they happened).
<b>Government</b>	A group of people that have power to make and change laws and rules.
<b>Collage</b>	A piece of art made by sticking various materials together.
